Bible Story Focus: Heroes of Faith

Hebrews 11:1 – 12:2

Key Passage: 2 Corinthians 5:17

Main Point: God helps us love Him.

Story Time

Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom to tell the story. Some kids (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!

What You Do: Introduce the story

People who love Jesus live by faith. Faith is when you believe something that you have not seen. We cannot love God without having faith. Faith tells us that God is real, His words are true, and He takes care of us when we trust Him. Many people in the Bible had faith in God. Abraham believed God's promise to give him a big family. Joseph in Egypt had faith that God would bring His people to the promised land. Moses had faith that God would save His people from the king of Egypt. Rahab had faith that God would save her family when Jericho fell. Many people in the Bible trusted that God would send Jesus! We have faith that God sent Jesus to rescue us.
